

Club Member Agreement

I Agree to:

Respect others at all times

Treat others respectfully. Use positive and respectful language.

Keep the Club Safe

Keep hands, feet, and property to self.

Bullying, teasing, picking on or ganging up on another club member, by a group of 2 or more members will not be tolerated.

Watching, or knowing about a fight without telling staff isn't acceptable.

Threatening language or behavior will not be tolerated.

Help out around the Club whenever you can

Keep the Club clean Pick up after yourself. Eat and drink in designated areas only.

Respect property

Gum chewing will not be tolerated.

Graffiti, defacing property, theft, and misuse of equipment won't be tolerated

Keep all valuables and personal property at home

Follow the Club dress code No hats, headgear, bandanas, scarves, half-shirts, and shirts promoting drugs, sex, and/or violence.

Always be in supervised areas and follow expectations specific to each area.

Listen to staff direction

For members who follow the club agreements, you will get much in return:

Participation in club activities, sports leagues, clubs, events, etc.

Trips are available: Sporting events, theatre, museums, movies, camping, etc.

Awards are given out by different departments.

Members of the Month are selected for leadership, growth and outstanding behavior.

The purpose of a behavioral agreement is to provide safety, teach important social skills and behaviors, and manage the different Boys and Girls Club areas and activities.

If a member receives 4 written warnings in a month then the member will need to meet with the Program Director or appointed staff. A call will be made to the member's home, and she/he will probably be given a one-day suspension. If a member is suspended then she/he will be suspended from extra curricular activities such as field trips, sporting events or evening programs for a week.

If a member gets suspended a second time in the same month, she/he will be suspended for two days and a family meeting needs to take place prior to members participating in club activities. If a member hits, trips, shoves, or kicks another member, he/she may be suspended without a warning.

Fighting or watching a fight or knowing about a fight without telling staff, will result in suspension.

Bullying, teasing, picking on or ganging up on another club member by a group of 2 or more members will result in a suspension, and meeting with parent/guardian.

Gum chewers will have a choice: clean up or go home.

Graffiti, defacing or destruction of property will result in a suspension in addition to cleaning and or repair costs.

I understand the Club Agreements and agree to support the Jordan Boys and Girls Club in promoting safe and positive social behaviors among club members.
