**Our Mission**

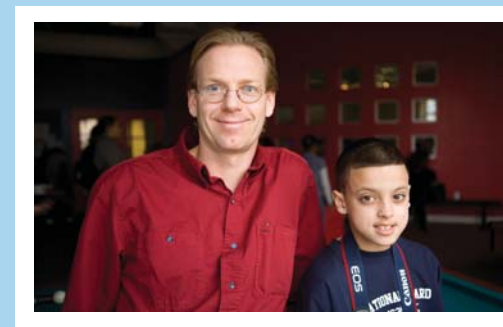
The mission of Boys & Girls Clubs of Boston is to help at-risk boys and girls develop the qualities needed to become responsible citizens and leaders.

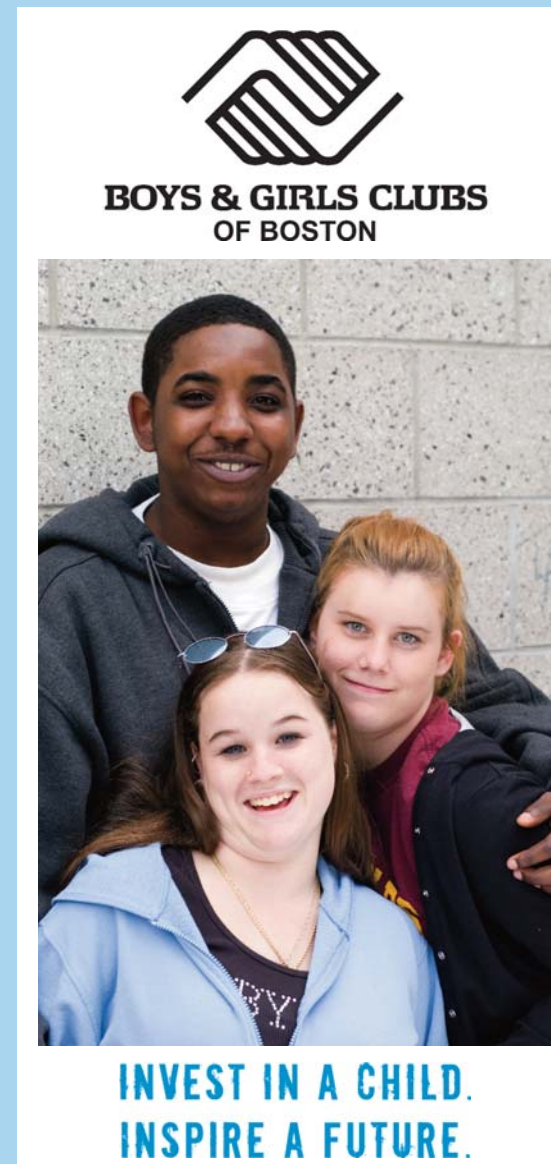
